  - Is there info available that can be shared that can be posted on the secure Coalition site





## **I-80** Weather Operations Focus





## Freight

- Freight considerations for Traveler Information and Mobility
- Leverage freight activities in partner states
  - I-5 truck parking
  - I-15 Truck Parking Study
- Advisory role/input
  - Road Weather Operations Task Force
  - Unique traveler information needs
- Maintain connections with private sector freight



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# ITS Mobile Application/Data Collection and Application Demonstration

- IMO: Multimodal initiative to enable wireless communications among vehicles, the infrastructure, and passengers personal communication devices.
- Application submitted to FHWA by NDOTand the National Center for Atmospheric Research (NCAR) Oct 2010
- Minnesota and Nevada accepted for demonstration project



## Objectives

- Promote safety, mobility and productivity on the nation's surface transportation system by advancing road weather research.
  - To reduce the environmental impact of surface transportation
- Demonstrate how weather, road condition and vehicle data can be integrated and used as a decision support tool for the IMO program.
- Integrate with FHWA's CLARUS system
- Test data quality, usability with Maintenance Decision Support System (MDSS) and the Maintenance Management System (MMS)



### **IMO** Details and Status

- NDOT supplying 19 vehicles along the I-80 corridor in a joint venture with University of Nevada Reno (UNR)
  - Snowplows 2004 and newer and light duty fleet vehicles
  - Aiming for a 1kb transmission every 10 min for each vehicle so an IMO vehicle reporting in every 30 seconds.
- Proof of Concept UNR snowplow CAN-bus data completed 4/8/2011
  - CAN-bus is a vehicle bus standard designed to allow microcontrollers and devices to communicate with each other within a vehicle without a host computer. It is the onboard diagnostics.



### IMO Details and Status (cont)

- Equipment being installed in phases
  - Two NDOT one snowplow and one light duty work begun last week
  - All 19 to be completed by 7/31/2011 with project date through to 3/30/2012
- Challenges:
  - Cell coverage on I-80 not always reliable
  - Using state radio system (limited channel capacity)
    - 800 Mhz Enhanced Digital Access Communications System (EDACS), RWIS currently uses EDACS
  - IMO applications is secondary to public safety applications



## IMO Details and Status (cont)

- Partners
  - NDOT
  - NCAR
  - FHWA Road Weather Management Program
  - FHWA CLARUS
- Research Outcomes
  - Integration with MDSS
    - Data collection in ASCII code and forwarded in comma delimited to NCAR



### IMO Details and Status (cont)

- Allow real-time mobile data information to be exchanged with DOT staff, as well as, traveler information systems.
- Measure efficiency gains (labor and material savings

   easy to do through snow/ice mgmt)
- Use Mobile Data
  - measure savings by calculating delay costs, tracking weather-related crashes, freight feedback
  - Plan on targeting WalMart, UPS, Federal Express, Malto Meal and C.R. England
