


Map of 180 near Stateline





















Existing Challenges

Statistics



- Frequency of Caltrans truck controls
- Daily truck volume
- Hourly truck volume
- Available truck parking
- Parking on I80 shoulder
- Queue length during a 1 ½ hour closure





Proposed Future Truck Stops



- Proposed new truck stops are development driven and subject to municipal approvals
 - Big Wheel Truck Stop in Fernley (exit 48)
 - TRCC Truck Stop at the Patrick interchange
 - Flying J at Robb Dr interchange
 - Boomtown Truck Stop at Garson Rd interchange

NO TRUCK PARKING WEST OF RENO DURING I-80 SNOW CLOSURES

The Boomtown* Truck Stop, located west of Reno on Interstate 80, has indefinitely closed.

Parking will not be available on I-80 or at Boomtown* during Donner Pass snow closures.

Due to limited motor vehicle parking in the Reno area, commercial vehicle operators are being asked to please make arrangements for truck stop and parking facilities east of Fernley during snow closures (see map on reverse).

NDOT Truck Restrictions on 180



- Experimental program
- Similar to Caltrans truck management program
- Coordinated effort between NDOT, NHP, Caltrans, & CHP
- Proposed truck controls on I80 between JCT95 and stateline
- Interim check points
- Proposal has severe impacts to truck drivers
 - Limited parking at truck stops in rural areas
 - Safety issues related to parking on freeway shoulders
 - Possible delays to freight deliveries
 - Drivers access to services (food, lodging, fuel, showers, restrooms, etc)
 - Clean up after events



Exemptions to Truck Restrictions



- Vehicles exempted by Caltrans would be exempted by NDOT
 - US Postal Service
 - Certain livestock sensitive to cold (pigs)
 - DOBBAS Trucking (UP contractor for the West Coast)
 - Fuel Trucks
 - California Prison Buses
- Vehicles with destinations in Nevada would be exempted
