FAQ Employment Sponsorship

What is employment sponsorship?

- Employment sponsorship is the process by which a US employer files a petition with US government agencies on behalf of a worker to assist that worker in obtaining a visa or green card for employment in the United States.
- This would apply to individuals whose immigration status is F-1, OPT, STEM OPT, H-1B, etc.
- Employment sponsorship from an employer is not guaranteed and is assessed on a case-by-case basis.

Does Kimley-Horn provide employment sponsorship for entry-level full-time positions?

- Sponsorship is role-specific; thus, Kimley-Horn only considers sponsorship for certain roles.
